SACA GUIDELINES FOR ABSENTEE 2021-22

With our primary objective being to protect the health and safety of our Members, players and staff during this unprecedented time, SACA remains flexible and is continuously adapting to changes and health directives as they occur.

To protect you and your rights as a Member, we have made some changes to the absentee qualification criteria and application process for the 2021-22 season.

2.6 Absentee list

(a) If a Member:

- (i) anticipates being absent from the state of South Australia, for a full Membership Year; or
- (ii) through extenuating circumstances anticipates being unable to enjoy or require their Membership for a full Membership Year,

that Member may make a written application to SACA to have their name placed on the absentee list.

(b) The Board or the Chief Executive may, in its absolute discretion, grant any application referred to in by-law 2.6(a) on such terms and conditions as it thinks fit.

1.7 Absentee list

(c) For the purposes of any application by a Member by-law 2.6(a)(ii) of Part A to have their name placed on the absentee list for the 2021/22 Membership Year, the Board has determined that accepted "extenuating circumstances" will include (but not be limited to) the following grounds:

- (i) a Member is located overseas or interstate (and therefore may be affected by COVID-19 travel restrictions);
- (ii) a Member or an immediate family member of a Member has a material medical condition, or is undergoing medical treatment, rendering them vulnerable to COVID-19;
- (iii) a Member is living with, or is a close contact or carer of, a person vulnerable to COVID-19;
- (iv) a Member is uncomfortable to attend matches due to health risks associated with the COVID-19 pandemic; or
- (v) a Member is experiencing financial hardship.

Members on the absentee list will have certain Membership rights and benefits suspended for the period they remain on the absentee list, including but not limited to entry to any Cricket Australia International and domestic matches at Adelaide Oval, the right to purchase Guest Passes, or to book for SACA Member hospitality at cricket matches or AFL matches at Adelaide Oval

1. To qualify for absentee, a Member must complete the online or above application form and qualify for any of the listed criteria.
2. To qualify for the absentee list, a fee of \$80 is applicable, and payment details must accompany the application form or be made in full by following the new online absentee application process.
3. An automatic late fee of \$40 will be applied for payments made after 1 October 2021. Cheques received after this date without the late fee included will be returned.
4. Members who have not paid their 2021-22 Membership Subscription fee or absentee fee by 31 October 2021 will have their Membership cancelled by the SACA Board.
5. Membership subscription forms for future seasons are automatically posted out the following year.
6. No Membership Card or ticket is issued whilst a Member is on the absentee list.
